

Rules and terms IAN-BAR-B-Q 2018

For the IAN-BAR-B-Q there will be an online round comprising of written multiple choice questions and final round at IANCON-2018 Raipur (Saturday 29th September 2:30-4:00 PM). This competition is essentially for DM/DNB students (first, second, third year) from all over India.

All teaching neurology departments across the country will be divided into four zones

- North Zone: New Delhi, Punjab, Haryana, Jammu and Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh
- South Zone: Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu
- West Zone: Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Goa, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Chattisgarh
- **East zone**: West Bengal, Assam, Orissa, Bihar and Jharkhand

LEVEL 1: ELIMINATION ROUND

Is an online round comprising of 30 multiple choice questions which can be attempted in 15 minutes only. The round will be open from 9:00 am, Friday, August 03, 2018 till 11:00 pm, Sunday, August 05, 2018

To participate in the quiz, log on to the IAN website (www.ianindia.org) follow the IAN-BAR-B-Q link displayed on the home page. Generate your unique user ID and password by registering yourself.

Registration Duration:

Participants should register from 9:00 am, 16th July to 11:00 pm, 27th July 2018

Rules for the online elimination round:

- Number of MCOs: 30
- Time allotted: 15 minutes
- Each correct answer will have +4 marks
- There will be negative mark (-1) for each wrong answer
- Top 2 participants from each zone will move for the next round at the, IANCON, Raipur 2018
- If there will be a tie in the elimination round, then the candidate who has seniority in the a DM course will be selected.
- If two participants have same seniority, then date of birth criteria will be taken into account (senior candidates will be given higher position).

Pre-Final Round

- There will be eight participants selected from the elimination round (two from each zones)
- Pattern of the contest: Participant will go through various rounds as MCQs, Spotters etc.
- Selection: Out of eight participants top four will be selected for the final Challenge round

Final Challenge Round

- Pattern of the contest: Participants will be exposed to Neuroradiology, case scenarios, rapid fire buzzer round, MCQs and spotters.
- The "IAN-BAR-B-Q Champion" will be announced during the Felicitation Ceremony.
- First runner and second runner will also be announced.



The winner name and prizes will be announced during the Felicitation Ceremony

The Champion will receive a "Running Trophy" and this trophy will remain with his/her department for a year.
