Dear Seniors, Colleagues and Residents,

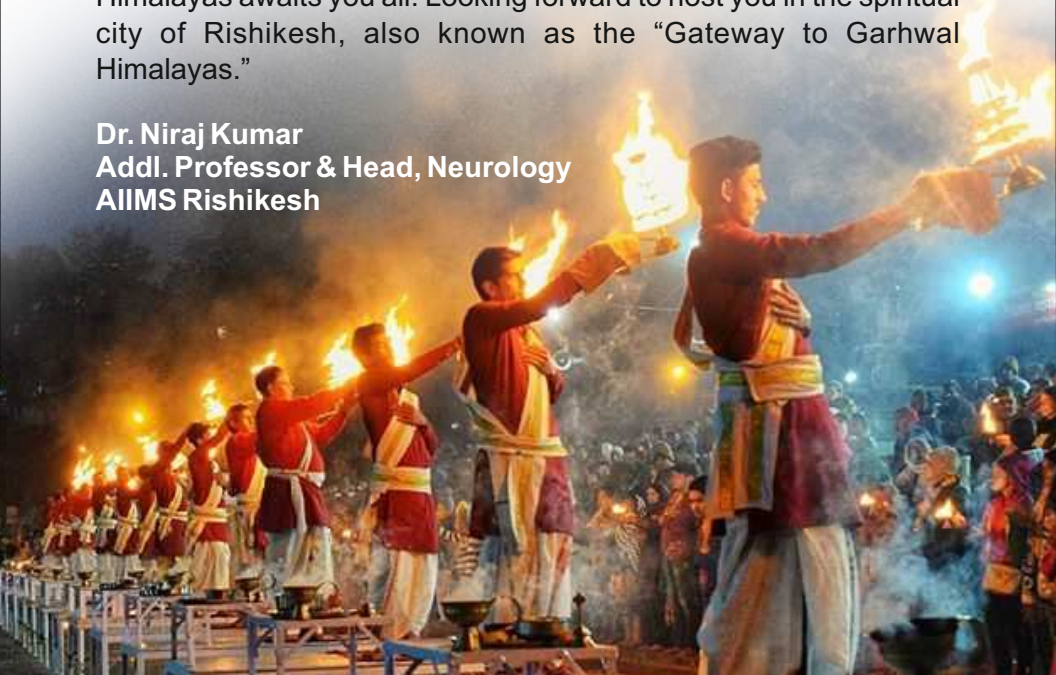
Greetings from All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Rishikesh!!
